

#### **Photo Documentation Workflow**






# Typical Workflow For Single Subject



- 1. Shoot a Single Subject
- 2. Search for Record by ID and / or Name to Load the subject Record
- 3. Select Load Single to import Photo Images into Record
- 4. Annotate Single Record, Create Reports, etc.





Select a Photo Image or an Enhancement for a report
Generate a Report based on selected Photo Images or Enhancements
Change the appearance of Enhancements, set the default color and pen size for new Enhancements
Control the Magnifier tool zoom level and on/off status
See the size of the ruler in the current Photo Image, manually or automatically set the ruler in the Photo Image
Nudge either the selected Enhancement or Magnifier
Open a Windows® Explorer window to show the Photo Image files, Reports,

and Output Photo Image currently loaded Record.



### **Zoom Keyboard Commands**



L	Action	Result
	licking the Scroll Wheel In - or – ressing the "+" Key	Zooms the Photo Image to the next higher level of magnification
	licking the Scroll Wheel Out - or – ressing the "-" Key	Zooms the Photo Image to the next lower level of magnification
a	ressing the Left Mouse Button Down - nd – Ioving the Mouse Pointer	Pans the Photo Image in the direction you move the Mouse.
U	p, Down, Left, or Right Arrow Key	Pans the Photo Image in the direction of the Arrow-Key, moving by the Nudge-Size Amount.
